It is time to choose who speaks for you. UNISON is a democratic organisation. That means that you elect people to speak up on your behalf at every level of the union. And the highest body in the union is the national executive council (NEC).

As a member you'll be receiving a ballot paper and will be asked to elect one or more candidates to represent your region or service group. A 500 word statement from each candidate may accompany the ballot paper.

It is important that your NEC reflects the union's membership and that you take your chance to have your say. The people you choose will make big decisions about your union, its policies and how it is run for the next two years.

The election will begin on 14 April 2009 and all ballot papers must be returned by 15 May 2009.
